







Activities Included



1. Young Explorers

Children will explore the property with naturalists, observing different plants, birds, insects, and animals.

2. What's That Bird?

To encourage birdwatching, children will participate in guided walks, use field guides to identify birds, and utilize mobile apps and sound recorders to recognize bird calls.

3. Plant for the Future

Young naturalists will create seed trays, plant indigenous saplings, and collect various plant seeds from the property.

4. Garden Bug-Hunt

Kids will explore the herb garden to find and learn about bugs, beetles, and caterpillars and their role in pollination.





Children will start their own nature journals, documenting their observations through drawings and notes using a notebook, pen, pencils, and crayons.

6. Pug Mark Making with Naturalists

Children will learn how to track animals by creating plaster casts of pug marks. This fun and educational activity enhances observational skills and teaches about animal behavior.

7. Rope Making / Pottery Session

Under the guidance of local artisans, kids will experience traditional rope-making techniques and pottery, gaining insight into indigenous crafts and sustainability.

8. Wildlife Documentary Screening

A special screening of an engaging wildlife documentary to help young minds understand and appreciate the beauty of nature and the importance of conservation.
